We've taken camping to another level with our new 'no fuss glamping'.


Stay in a repurposed shipping container, perfect whatever the weather - without the hassle of putting up a tent!

 - Field area around the accommodation






- We have emergency evacuation procedures.

Getting here

Tapnell Farm Newport Road Yarmouth PO41 0YJ



- You can get to Camp Tapnell by boat or ferry.
- The nearest port is Yarmouth. The port is 3.6 miles / 5.8 km from Camp Tapnell.
- Wightlink sail from Lymington to Yarmouth or Portsmouth to Fishbourne. Sailings from Southampton to East Cowes are with Red Funnel
- Daily from 29th March to 28th September 2024, you can now catch the bus to Tapnell Farm from Newport Bus Station (Stand B) or Yarmouth (Stand C). The bus stop at Tapnell farm is right outside camp Tapnell.


Pathway to accommodation

- The main entrance has 1 step.

A Bedrooms

- All bedrooms have windows.
- All bedrooms are non-smoking.
- No bedrooms have fitted carpets.
- Floors are laminated, guests bring their own linen, duvets, and pillows. We provide a mattress protector and sheet.
- The bedroom nearest the main entrance has 1 step.
- Some toilets have handrails.
- The walls and the fittings have high colour contrast.
- The direction of transfer onto the toilet is to the left and right.

Communal kitchen

- From the main entrance to the kitchen, there is level access.
- The route is 1400mm wide, or more.
- Plates and cutlery are not provided.

- From the main entrance to the area, there is 1 step.
- Camp Tapnell accommodation units are based in a field with walking routes close by
